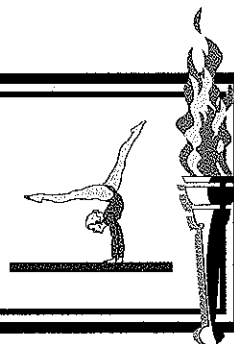

During the month of August we will begin signing new students as well as reregistering current ones. Important changes to note.:

Annual Registration Fees as well as tuition is Due at time of registration. (September 7th - 11th) Registration Fees are: \$25.00 for age 12 and under or \$50.00 13 years of age & up (if your student turns 13 during the month of Sept please pay the \$50.00 fee.)

Class times will change slightly due to a change in the Klamath County Schools Scheduling. Students who are currently enrolled for the 2:45 PM class will find the September class will now begin at 3:00 PM to allow those students additional time to make practice.

All Current Students must Sign a new parent check list, club waiver, registration card, photo release and pay the tuition & registration fees prior to Start of First September class. No student will be allowed to participate without new paperwork.

In addition Current Students who need to change their day, class time or add an extra class in September you need to do this as soon as possible. New Students will begin enrolling soon and all spaces will be filled. Check with Brandi on available class times August 1st.
